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Sub: Continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Ayush & Health University in respect of students being trained at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur -Reg.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform that compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Ayush & Health University in respect of students being trained at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Chhattisgarh was carried out by the Council Assessors on (15<sup>th</sup> January, 2016). The compliance verification assessment report (15<sup>th</sup> January, 2016) along with previous compliance verification assessment report (2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2015) and assessment report (10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2014) was circulated to the Executive Committee members for consideration and their comments/observations have been received on 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> Jan., 2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016:-

"The General Body of the Council noted that the compliance verification assessment report (15<sup>th</sup> January, 2016) along with previous compliance verification assessment report (2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2015) and assessment report (10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2014) was circulated to the members of the Executive Committee for consideration on 16-01-2016 & 18-01-2016 and unanimously the members of the Executive Committee decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Guru Ghasidas University in respect of students being trained at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur be continued restricting the number of admission to 100 (One Hundred) students."

In view of above, the Council approved the above decision of the Executive Committee recommending the recognition of MBBS degree granted by Guru Ghasidas University in respect of students being trained at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur be continued restricting the number of admission to 100 (One Hundred) students.

The Council further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

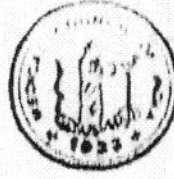
8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute..."

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration of fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition by the Council and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is liable not to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 100 students and this approval is also liable to be revoked. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

Subject: Renewal of permission for admission of 4<sup>th</sup> Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 100-150 at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur for the academic year 2016-17.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to MCI's letter No. MCI-37(1)(RI-22)/2015-Med./108911 dated 14.05.2016 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government for renewal of permission for admission of 4<sup>th</sup> Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 100-150 for the academic year 2016-17 at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur under Chhattisgarh Ayush & Health Sciences University.

2. The permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of students against increased intake i.e. from 100-150 during the academic session 2016-17. The next batch of students in MBBS course against increased intake will be admitted in the college only after permission of Central Government for renewal/recognition.

3. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made thereunder.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of MCI and the Central/State Government.
